## Directions to Mill Neck Manor



Take LI Expwy. to exit 41N or Northern State Pkwy. to exit 35N. Take Route 106N into Oyster Bay. At light (Hess Station), turn left onto Lexington Ave. At the 2nd light, turn left onto West Main St. Go under RR trestle (West Main becomes West Shore Rd.), At 1st light, make a left on Cleft Rd. Take Cleft Rd. to Frost Mill Rd., make a left. Our entrance is on the left.
